DOCUMENT CHECKLIST for *Grenada*Citizenship by Investment

Government Application Forms:

- 1. Personal Information Form
- 2. Fingerprints
- 3. Home Office Particulars Form
- 4. Medical Form
- 5. Employment Status, Source of Funds and Business
- 6. Investment Confirmation Form
- 7. Oath of Allegiance
- 8. Passport Form

Other Supporting Documents:

- 1. Original Police Certificate
- 2. Original or certified Birth or Adoption Records; must submit documents to support any change of name and an affidavit if there are any discrepancies in the spelling of names or translation of names
- 3. Original or Certified college or university transcripts for children at least 18 years and over attending university
- 4. Original sworn affidavit of support for each dependent over 18 years
- 5. Original HIV test result; must be done for each applicant save all minor dependents under the age of twelve (12) are NOT required to submit an HIV test result provided that the biological mother is HIV Negative. All applicants aged twelve (12) or older are still required to submit their HIV test result. It therefore follows, that in cases where the biological mother is not a party to the application, her HIV test result must be submitted with the application. The validity period for HIV test is three months. In instances where the biological mother is unavailable or unwilling, an HIV test result would be required for the minor child, as per normal
- 6. Original Proof of source of funds MUST be provided. This may include bank statements, pay slips, job letters, company certificates and incorporation documents to support business activities from which source is generated, business assets, real estate holdings or proof of dispositions of same etc.
- 7. Original CV or resume for main applicant and spouse
- 8. Original or Certified copies of Diplomas or Certificates (provide in colour whereapplicable)
- 9. Twelve (12) current passport size photographs in colour per applicant. The size of the photographs must not be more than 2 ½ inches by 2 inches or less than 2 inches by 1 ½ inches. The photograph must be taken full face without hat or covered hair (save for religious purposes and even then, the forehead and the ears MUST be visible). The photograph must not be mounted. The photograph must be printed on normal thin photographic paper and must not be glazed on the reverse side. Two (2) photographs must be certified by a notary public (or where unable an attorney-at law or medical doctor) who knows the identity of the person(s) in the picture by endorsing on the reverse side of the picture "I certify that this is a true likeness of the applicant (state name)" and affixing his/her signature thereafter
- 10. Certified Coloured copy of ALL passports possessed (ALL pages)
- 11. Certified Coloured copy of ALL current national identity cards and or driver's licence
- 12. Original or Certified copy of marriage and divorce certificates (if applicable)
- 13. Original Professional Reference
- 14. Original Bank Reference; xv. Original Proof of Address Original document proving applicant's residential address, such as utility bill, bank statement, or written confirmation from a bank, an attorney, a chartered accountant or notary public confirming applicant's address.

All color copies must be notarized and legalized prior to submission. All documents not in English must be translated, notarized, and legalized.
